It all started in February 2004. With just one presentation to the Upper Sandusky Park Board, the plans for a 18 hole Disc Golf Course have nearly become a reality. Information supplied to the Park Board as well as follow up calls and a couple of short meetings have proven to be extremely positive to the installation of the Reservoir DG course. The property, a 20 acre plot, was approved for use in March of 2004. After that time Mike Cheney (Park Manager) and Craig Swartz (City Council)

scheduled a meeting with Ken Rollins to approve the course design.

On April 17, 2004, the three met at the park to conduct a walk thru of the park. The design of the course was well received with some small modifications by Mike. His traditional golf experience had proven to be a great asset to the flow of the new design.

As for the disposition of the course and equipment, Mike contacted and ordered 18 Innova DISCatcher® targets. The park board has

plans to install the front nine by Memorial Day weekend.

We have hopes of a speedy back nine as well as a tournament in the not so distant future. Watch for a date to be posted as soon as a date is set.
