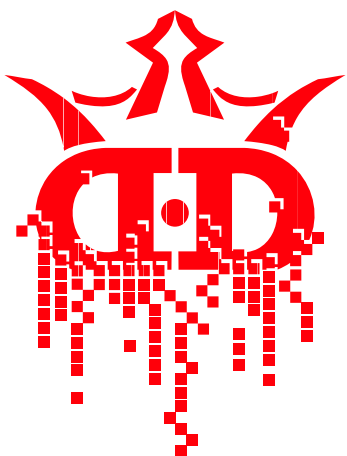
From TD Kristy Moore and the hosting Ladies!

Gordon Holton Memorial Disc Golf Course

The lake is OB on all holes (Bring disc in one meter to safe stance) One penalty stroke.

All asphalt on and beyond is OB except long tee #13

Two Meter Rule in Effect ALL HOLES both rounds.

Hole 11 - Mando to right of marked tree. If missed proceed to drop zone. 1 stroke penalty.

Hole 13 - On road directly in front of long tee is OB. Road right and behind pin on or across is OB.

Hole 15 - Creek played as casual. NO OB

Hole 16 - Volleyball court is OB.

Hole 17 - Creek played as casual. NO OB

Hole 21 - Asphalt, parking lot and all islands are OB. Must be on top of curb to be in bounds. Leaner on curb do not count as in bounds.

GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES

- **This is a PDGA sanctioned event and all rules governing play according to the PDGA are in effect for the duration of the tournament.** Please abide by any park/local/state/federal regulations. Failure to follow the rules can be grounds for event disqualification and other possible disciplinary action.
- If there is a scoring or rule dispute that cannot be resolved within the player's group and an Official is not available, use a provisional throw, record both scores, and continue the round. Consult the TD for a ruling at the end of the round. As it relates to score keeping follow the rotation or if a player volunteers to carry card for the entire round as long as it is ok with the group. If a score needs to be changed for any reason BE SURE that all players in group are present.
- Be mindful of your fellow competitors. Please have cell phones in silence mode and limit use during the round. We encourage picture taking but be sure to ask and stay out of sight line when possible.

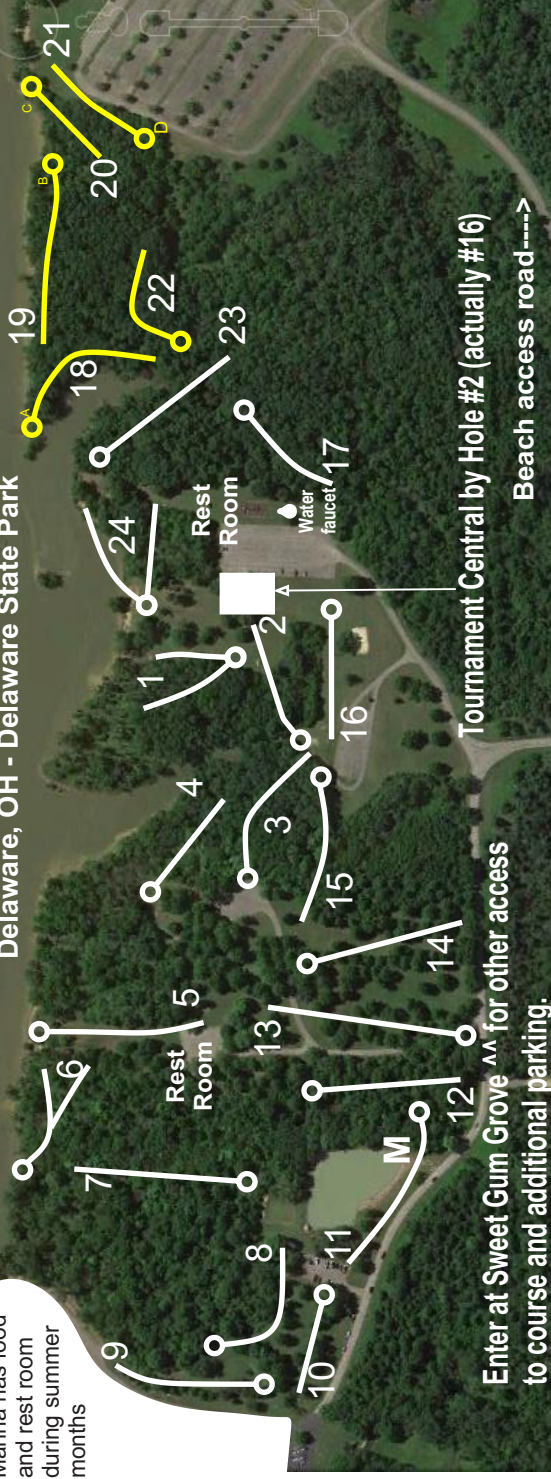

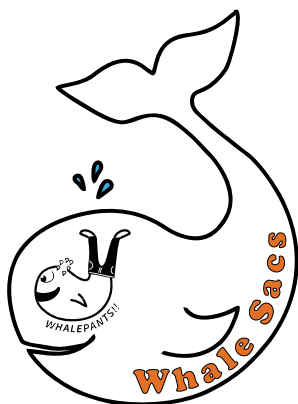

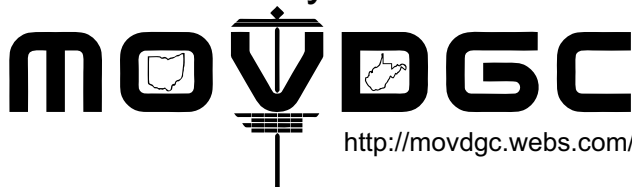
